The foregoing statement of an account current comprises all the debits and credits which can be supported by papers, vouchers (or other information to be relied on.) The ~~executorial~~ transactions of Micajah Griffin executor of Benja^a having been managed

in a very loose way it cannot be pretended that an account thereof can be made with any tolerable degree of accuracy. - The M. Commissioner is however persuaded that further light, or information cannot be had on the subject; and therefore very respectfully submits this statement as the result of much pains and attention to the attainment of truth, and an equitable adjustment of the estate.

There is no compensation allowed to Mike Griffin the Executor for his trouble in the settlement of Benja. Griffin's Estate; and therefore no interest is charged on the balance due from him: these two items are intended to stand in balance each other, no better method existing itself in doing justice to the parties - as the whole transaction is in confusion & much intricacy, from the length of time it has remained unsettled, and the irregular manner of keeping the accounts.
