E. course to Apple tree thence near Cove suppose one hundred feet of the dwelling house straight line marked bees to Thundred line thence down Thundred line to Cooks line thence up Cooks line to the beginning supposing to be sixty five acres. Given under ^{our} hands this 23rd day of Decemb^r. 1848, and submitted to the Court
