Wellons departed this life some time in the
year having first made and published his
last will and Testaments, and was at the time
of his death justly indebted to your com-
plainant a sum of \$58.34. due by bond 28th March 1859, as will

the said Wilson Wellons was in his lifetime
and at the time of his death, seized and possessed of
considerable personal estate, but totally
insufficient to pay his debts, and was also
seized and possessed of considerable real estate
and particularly of a tract of land lying in
Southampton County containing about one
and more or less about \$400.00 - That the said
Wellons being so seized and possessed departed
this life in the year 1851 - Having first
made his last will and Testaments being
the following as his legatees, to wit: William
Wellons, Mary the spouse of Wm. H. H. and John

"B" and prayed to be taken as a part of this
