

that an iffe be made up and tried by a jury at the bar of this Court, to determine whether Doctor Joyce died testate or intestate, and if testate, whether of his real and personal estate or of the latter only, and in what manner he disposed of the same, and whether the paper writing in the will mentioned was made and published by the said Doctor Joyce in his lifetime. And the Court doth further order that if from any cause, the attorney who has deputed in this cause, cannot personally attend on the trial of said cause, their deponent shall in the cause, be to be read as evidence on the said Trial.

Ordered that the cause be adjourned till tomorrow morning nine O'Clock.

This cause came on this day for a final hearing, by consent of parties, and by like consent. It is ordered and decr'd that the defendant Sam Rochelle administrator with the will annexed of John Thomas out of any effects of his testator in his hands to be administered pay to the plaintiff Davis Barret^t the sum of four hundred and eighty seven dollars and forty four cents with Interest thereon from the 25th day of December 1829 till paid. To Barnwell Everett as administrator of his wife Elizabeth who was Eliza Barret^t d^r five hundred and fifteen dollars sixteen cents with the interest, - and to Benjamin Barret^t the sum of five hundred and twenty four dollars and thirty one cents with like interest being the sums respectively reported by Master Comptroller off in his account as exhibit in this cause, due them from John Spencer their late guardian. These balances are by agreement to be credited by any advancements made for them respectively by John Thomas after the death of the said John Spencer. That deducted these sums with Interest in due to the 25th day of Decem^r 1829 from the balance reported by the said Comptroller in his account of John Thomas' transactions as administrator d^r of John Spencer d^r due from the said administrator to his decedent estate, the balance thus ascertained being left to division between Nancy Barret^t widow of John Spencer d^r and Richard Carter Spencer his only child. She taking one third and his two thirds thereof and that by the death of the said Richard Carter, his said proportion became distributable between his mother as of the whole blood and his surviving brother Davis and Benjamin Barret^t of the half blood, the said Eliza being dead.
