

that an issue be made up and tried by a jury at the bar of the Court to determine whether Jordan Joyce did seduce or entice, and if seduce, whether of his own and personal estate or of the latter only, and on what manner he disposed of the same, and whether the property in this bill mentioned was made and published by the said Jordan Joyce in his lifetime. And the Court doth further order that if from any cause, the attorney who have appeared in this cause, cannot personally attend on the trial of said issue, their depositions filed in this cause, are to be read as evidence on the said trial.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning Nine o'clock.

Now Comes Sheriff of Southampton County and Comptroller of the estate of John Barrett dec^d. James Richelle administrator with the will annexed of John Thomas dec^d. Stiff. whereas administrator with the will annexed of John Spencer dec^d who was guardian to Davis, Elizabeth and Benjamin Barrett.

This cause came on this day for a final hearing, by consent of parties, and by the Court. It is ordered and decreed that the defendant James Richelle administrator with the will annexed of John Thomas out of any assets of his testator in his hands to be administered pay to the plaintiff Davis Barrett the sum of four hundred and eighty seven dollars and forty four cents with interest thereon from the 31st day of December 1825 till paid, to Barrett Everett as administrator of his wife Elizabeth who was Edg^e Barrett dec^d five hundred and fifteen dollars interest with like interest, and to Benjamin Barrett the sum of four hundred and twenty four dollars and thirty one cents with like interest, being the sums respectively reported by John Spencer Commissioner of the said account as exhibited in the cause, due them from John Spencer their late guardian. these balances are by agreement to be certified by any acknowledgments made for them respectively by John Thomas after the death of the said John Spencer. That deducting these sums with interest on them to the 31st day of December 1829 from the balance reported by the said Commissioner in his account of John Thomas transactions as administrator of John Spencer dec^d due from the said administrator to his decedent estate, the balance thus ascertained being paid to division between Nancy Barrett widow of John Spencer dec^d and Richard Barton Spencer her only child. she taking one third and the two thirds thereof and that by the death of the said Richard Barton, his said proportion became distributable between his mother as of the whole blood and his surviving brothers Davis and Benjamin Barrett. of the half blood, the said Edg^e being dead. His therefore
