

decreed that on the execution of justice regarding bonds the said Rockelle as administrator of the said Thomas de^r out of assets in his hands pay to Henry Spence as administrator of the deceased wife Stoney, the sum of four hundred and fifty six dollars fifty seven cents with interest thereon from the 25th day of December 1829, her one third of the balance due from the said Thomas as administrator of the said Spence, also the sum of four hundred fifty six dollars fifty seven cents with like interest being her moiety of Richard Carter Spence's distributive share - but she shall not be creditor for the amount exhibited against the said Nancy Spence of Two hundred and thirteen dollars and ninety two cents as on the 25th December 1830 over the balance thereof deducted by the said Rockelle on account exacted by the said Nancy and Parker Barrett as her party, to the said Thomas as administrator of the said Spence de^r. That the said Rockelle administrator &c as aforesaid, deposit to the plaintiff Davis Barrett the further sum of Two hundred and twenty eight dollars twenty three and a half cents with interest thereon from the 25th day of December 1829 and the like sum and like interest to Benjamin J. Barrett, there being thus distributed his share of the proportion of Richard Carter Spence - that she can be paid by the respective parties - By consent of parties Richard Warder is permitted to have the benefit of the dues, he accounting with the plaintiff respectively for the proportions due, that, in connection with payments heretofore made by him to stand on that account.
