This cause came on this day to be heard on the bill, the answer of the defendants, replication, depositions, exhibits filed and examination of witnesses. On consideration whereof it appearing that the plaintiff has not shewn proof of the facts stated in the bill, the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the bill of the plaintiff be dismissed and that he pay to the defendant his costs by them about their defence in this behalf expended to be levied of the goods and chattels of the said Williams in his hands to be administered.

On consideration whereof (the plaintiff waiving any account against Moore executrix as aforesaid) the Court doth adjudge, order and decree, that the complainant recover against the defendants Randolph B. Gardner and wife the following sums of money to wit. The complainant George B. Gardner the sum of One hundred dollars with legal interest thereon to be computed from the 31st day of May 1834 till paid, the complainant Harriet M. Gardner the like sum with interest as aforesaid, the complainant Isaac B. Gardner the like sum with like sum with interest as aforesaid, the complainant Celina M. Gardner the like sum with interest as aforesaid, the complainant Louisa F. Gardner the like sum with interest as aforesaid, and the complainant Margaret A. Gardner the like sum with interest as aforesaid. And the Court doth also decree that the said Defendants Randolph B. Gardner and Phoebe his wife pay the costs of this suit in this behalf expended.
