This cause came on again to be heard upon the papers formerly read together with the original and amended reports of the Commissioner made pursuant to the order of the 5th day of November 1832 and of the 11th day of July 1834 and exceptions to the said reports by the plaintiff. On consideration whereof the Court sustaining the said exceptions with a proviso, order and decree that the defendants George Eury James P. Holt and John Wrensch pay to the plaintiff the sum of One hundred and twenty two dollars and eleven cents with legal interest thereon to be computed from the 31st day of December 1811 (to wit) that the defendant George Eury administrator with the will annexed of Thomas Eury dec^d pay to the plaintiff the sum of Eight hundred and fifty nine dollars and eighty three cents with legal interest thereon to be computed from the 23rd day of December 1832 till paid, and that the defendant George Eury administrator with the will of Thomas Eury dec^d pay to the defendant Charlotte Eury the sum of Nine hundred and forty seven dollars and eighty seven cents with legal interest thereon to be computed from the 7th day of September 1831 till paid, and the Court with further proviso, order and decree that the defendants George Eury James P. Holt and John Wrensch pay to the plaintiff one half of the costs about the said in the behalf of the plaintiff and that the other half thereof be paid by the defendant

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
