This cause came on again to be heard upon the proofs formerly made together with the
original and unsweld report of the Commissioner made pursuant to the order of the 5th day of
November 1832 and of the 11th day of July 1834 and exceptions to the said report by the plaintiff.
On consideration whereof the Court sustaining the said exceptions doth hereby order and decree that
the defendant George Lucy James P Holl and John Hancock pay to the plaintiff the sum
of One hundred and twenty two dollars and eleven cents with legal interest thereon to be computed
from the 21st day of December 1831 till paid. that the defendant George Lucy administrator
with the will annexed of Thomas Lucy deceased pay to the plaintiff the sum of Eight hundred and
fifty nine dollars and eighty three cents with legal interest thereon to be computed from the 23rd
day of December 1832 till paid. and that the defendant George Lucy administrator with the
will of Thomas Lucy deceased pay to the defendant Charlotte Lucy the sum of one hundred and
forty seven dollars and eighty seven cents with legal interest thereon to be computed from the 1st
day of September 1831 till paid. And the Court doth further equity's sake and doth that the
