This cause came on this day to be further heard on the papers formerly read and the report of the Commissioner to which no exceptions are filed, and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court with adjudge, order and decree, that the defendants Harry Applewhite, Thomas Ridley and Alexander P. Peete do pay to the plaintiff the sum of twelve dollars and seventy five cents without cost, eleven from the 21st day of December in the year 1828 till paid; and that the defendants Alexander P. Peete, Benjamin Lewis, and George A. W. Aarons as the administrators of Harvey Aarons deceased, out of the assets in his hands to be administered do pay to the plaintiff the sum of four hundred and ninety two dollars and fifty nine cents with interest on four hundred and twelve dollars and thirty seven cents from the 21st day of December in the year 1833 till paid; and that the costs sustained by the plaintiff in this suit be paid in equal proportions by the defendants Harry Applewhite, Thomas Ridley and Alexander P. Peete on the one part, and the Defendant Alexander P. Peete, Benjamin Lewis and George A. W. Aarons as the administrators of Harvey Aarons deceased, out of the assets in his hands to be administered, on the other part.

This cause came on to be heard on the original and amended bills, the answers of the defendants, replications thereto, exhibits filed and the examination of witnesses; on consideration whereof the Court with adjudge, order and decree that a Commissioner of the Court, take an account of the expenditures made by William Croffier to Allen Cuevas as to Joseph Jones on account of the litigation given by the said William Croffier to the said Joseph Jones together with Allen Cuevas his debtors as also settle all their private or individual accounts remaining open between the said complainant and the said defendant Allen Cuevas, and that the Commissioner make report with any remarks deemed pertinent by him self or which may be required by the parties to be stated.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till the morning 10. O'clock.
