This cause comes on this day to be heard, on the bill answer and exhibits filed and was argued by counsells on consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree, that the defendant out of the effects in his hands to be administered paye unto the complainant Nathaniel D. Land the sum of eighty eight dollars and nine cents with interest from the first day of July 1831 till paid. To the complainant Stephen Mardeau administrator of Nathaniel Rockelle and the sum of one hundred and thirty four dollars and ninety one cents with interest on one hundred and six dollars & twenty eight cents therefrom forthwith. And thuse from the first day of July 1831 till paid. To the complainant Robert Rockelle the sum of one hundred and thirty four dollars and ninety one cents, with interest on one hundred and six dollars & twenty eight cents therefrom forthwith from the first day of July 1831 till paid. But the complainants are adt to be estauled to the benefit of the same with they respectively, in some person for whom shall have executors or funding bonds payable to the said defendant on the sum of two hundred and sixty nine dollars and eighty two cents, entituled to recover out partions of all rents or awards which may hereafter arise against the estate of the said Robt Rockelle and together with the cost & disbursements in the recovery of the same.
