This day this cause came on to be argued before the judges formerly read and
the answer of John B. Mason the guardian ad litem of the said infants and
the answer of Martha J Wright and Weldon O Wright who are over the age
of fourteen years which was filed and came on by consent and was argued by
Counsel. On mature consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and
decree that John B. Mason as the Commissioner of this Court after having
given notice of the time and place of sale for a reasonable time in some
Newspaper in the Town of Petersburg and in the neighborhood of the premises
do sell the tract of land in the proceedings mentioned, requiring one third
of the purchase money in cash and giving credit for the other two thirds one
and two years in equal annual instalments, and that the said Commissioner take
of the purchaser bond and good security for the purchase money as above indicated
redwing the title until the payment of the purchase money, and that having made
sale on the terms aforesaid that he report his proceedings in the premises together
with the said bonds to this Court preparatory to a final decree.
