And the said Committee is directed to include in his said account the number and probable value of the slaves, if any, now in the hands of the defendant Robtelle as Committee as aforesaid, and the titles of the same, and he is moreover directed to make up an account showing the proportionate or shares to which the debtors of the said Sally Neurum are respectively entitled - which account the Committee is directed to examine state and settle and to the Court report with any matters specially stated during pertinent by himself or which may be required by the parties to this suit.
