 Mandough administrator of Nathaniel Rockelle *de*; Benjamin Downy Committee
 of the estate of William L. Rockelle *de*; and Francis Rockelle and four months having
 elapsed since the filing of the bill and the service of the subpoena and they failing
 to appear and file their answers, on the motion of the plaintiff by Counsel their bill
 is taken for confessed as to those defendants and the cause coming on to be heard
 upon the bill, the answers of the infant defendants, replication thereto, and exhibits
 filed, was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge,
 order and decree that the Commissioners of this Court do take the following accounts
 to wit: 1st An account of the debts of the administrators of Nathaniel Rockelle *de*
 shewing the amount of debts that have been paid, that bound the heirs and what
 debts have been paid that did not bind the heirs, also shewing the state of said
 administrators account generally. And that he further report what debts are still
 unpaid which bind the heirs and the outstanding debts that do not bind the heirs
 but are entitled to come in upon the doctrine of substitution. And an account of
 the real estate to which Nathaniel Rockelle *de* entitled and which upon his
 death descended to his heirs shewing the absolute and annual value thereof, and
 liberty is reserved to all the other creditors of the said Nathaniel Rockelle to exhibit
 and prove their respective demands before the Commissioners. which said several
 accounts the said Commissioners is directed to examine, state and report with
 any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself to which may be
 required by the parties to be so stated.
