 filed, was argued by Counsel: On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge,  
 order and decree that the Commissioner of this Court do take the following account  
 to wit. 1<sup>o</sup>. An account of the debts of the administration of Nathaniel Rockelle dec'd  
 showing the amount of debts that have been paid, that bound the heirs and what  
 debts have been paid that did not bind the heirs, also showing the state of said  
 administrators account generally. 2<sup>o</sup>. That he further report what debts are still  
 unpaid which bind the heirs and the outstanding debt that does not bind the heirs  
 but are entitled to come in upon the doctrine of Substitution. 3<sup>o</sup>. An account of  
 the real estate to which Nathaniel Rockelle died entitled and which upon his  
 death descended to his heirs showing the absolute and annual value thereof, and  
 liberty is reserved to all the other creditors of the said Nathaniel Rockelle to exhibit  
 and prove their respective demands before the Commissioner. which said several  
 accounts the said Commissioner is directed to examine, state and report with  
 any matter specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which may be  
 required by the parties to be so stated.
