This day this cause came on to be heard on the bill, answer, replication thereto, exhibits, depositions and argument of counsel. On consideration whereof the Court pronouncing no further opinion doth adjudge, order and decree, that an issue be made up, and tried by a jury before the Superior Court of Law, for the County of Southampton to ascertain. First the consideration upon which the deed from Sarah H. Fells and Martha Fells to John Bain bearing date the second day of February 1835 was filed as an exhibit in this case was founded. Secondly, whether or not at that time the said Martha Fells was deaf and dumb, and incapable of executing a valid contract. And thirdly, whether the said deed as to the said Sarah H. and Martha Fells or either of them was obtained by fraud or other illegal or undue means. Upon the trial of which issue the witness whose depositions have been taken may be called on, together with such other competent witness and legal evidence as may be introduced by either party, reserving to either party the right to rely upon the depositions in this case if the witness whose deposition has been taken, have died since the institution of this suit or their presence in court cannot be obtained at the trial of said issue.
