On consideration whereof the Court with Confession do to be paid by the aforesaid decoree the bond of Henry Henderson & Nicholas all Peckolt payable to the Commissioners as aforesaid for the sum of \$716.39 due 26th February 1840 and filed 20th Still remains for collection and distribution, between the other creditors of the said N^o Rochelle, the Court with therefore decree and order that the aforesaid Bute proceed to collect said bond, and it appearing to the Court that the following debts are still due and unpaid against the estate of the aforesaid N^o Rochelle and for the payment whereof the aforesaid sum of \$714.39 with the accruing interest thereon is responsible that it is
