and thirty two and three fourth cents to Christopher Smith and wife the like sum to James Turner
the like sum to Nathan Butler and wife those dollars and twenty three cents to Thomas Reed
the like sum to James Wade and wife the like sum to John F. Reed the sum of one dollar and
eighteen cents to Sterling Reed the like sum to Charles Winston the sum of three dollars
