This Cause came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read, and the
report of Commissioners held to which no exceptions were filed, and was argued by
Counsel. On Consideration whereof the Court Confirming said report and adjudge
order and decree that Edwards Butts be appointed a Commissioner to sell the tract
of land mentioned in the said proceedings of which the said John Ferguson
died seized and possessed containing forty acres and a tract of nine months
subject however to the widow's claim, wherein except as to so much in
ready Money as shall be sufficient to pay the Costs and expenses of this
suit and charges of sale taking from the purchaser bond with appearance
Security for the amount of the purchase Money except so much as has
been directed to be paid in Cash. And said Commissioner is directed
further to report his proceedings to this Court in order to a final decree
and not to execute to the purchaser any Conveyance for said land until
the said bond for the purchase Money shall be paid or until the further
order of this Court.

This cause came on this day to be further heard upon the papers formerly
read together with the special report of Commissioners held and the report
of Edwards Butts, who was appointed a Commissioner to sell the tract of land
of which Edwin Pittaway died seized and possessed mentioned in the proceeding
to neither of which reports exceptions have been filed and was argued by
Counsel upon Consideration whereof the Court Confirming both reports and
adjudge order and decree that Edwards Butts shall proceed to collect the
land taken by him for the sale of the tract of land belonging to Edwin
Pittaway which land has been returned to this Court and is filed with
the papers in this cause and was due and payable on the 16th day of
last January and which land is directed to be delivered to the said Butts
for the purpose of being collected and the said Butts is directed to take
all proper means to collect the same as speedily as possible and when collected
first to pay out of the amount all proper charges and Commissions for collecting
the same, next the Costs and expenses of this suit, and it appearing to
the Court by the acton entered herein on the 4th day of April in the
year 1836 that the balance of Edwin Pittaway is indebted to the following
persons as follows to wit to the plaintiff Isaac Bonduell the sum of
Seventy three dollars and fifty five cents with interest on fifty dollars and
eighty nine cents paid thereon from April 7th 1836 and on eight dollars
and two cents thereon from the date of the said interlocutory decree till paid
