This Cause came on this day to be again heard on the proper of former cause and the  
Verdict of the jury found in the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery for Southw-

ampton County upon the issue or order in this Cause on the day of April 1839 and  
was agreed by Counsel; On Consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge and order  
that the sum filed in this Cause and marked as exhibit A purporting to be a bill  
of sale executed by Martha Hall and Tally Hall to John Baird and bearing date  
the 2<sup>d</sup> of February 1835 was founded on no Valuable Considerations and that the  
same ~~and all monies~~ was obtained by fraud, and that the same therefore is null  
and void and in the Court doth adjudge and decree that the plaintiff Benjamin  
Griffin Committee of the estate of Tally Hall exec of the defendant John Baird  
give witness and has stated before me himself the increase of the said  
female since the second February 1835 and that the plaintiff Esq<sup>r</sup> G. Bates Com-  
mittee of Martha Hall exec of said defendant John Baird slavery, Sibley Bob-#6  
Jane and the increase of the female since 2<sup>d</sup> February 1835. And the Court  
doth further Order that a Court of the Court take an account of the birth of  
said slavery since the second of February 1835 stating the profits of each of said  
slavery and by whom they were held and make report to this Court with any  
written demand presented by himself or required by the party or either of them  
to be presented.
