On motion of the plaintiff it is moved that this suit be considered in the name of Archibald P Pond he having arrived to the age of twenty one years; and that, come on to be heard on the bill annexed and exhibits filed, and was required by Counsel on considerations whereof the Court doth adjudge decrees and costs that Edmund Butts after giving at least twenty days notice of the time and place of sale at the door of the Court House of this County and at such other places as may be deemed expedient call to the highest bidder on some Court day at the Court House of this County the slaves held by the defendant and wife in Tenants for life and the remainder in which belongs to the Complacant Archibald P Pond for money; that after paying the expenses of sale and of this suit the said Commissioners pay to Edmund Butts late Sheriff of Southampton County the sum of fifty three dollars and four pence and be answerable to be sure for the support of the said slaves since the same have been under their care by virtue of an involuntary order of this Court, and that of the net proceeds he pay over to Edmund Butts whom the parties agree to be the purchaser from the said Melton of his interest in said slaves one seventh part being advanced by the Court as equivalent for the life estate of the said Harriet Melton in said slaves, three of the balance pay to the said Edmund Butts as purchaser referred in right of said Melton's wife three tenths and the other seven tenths pay to Archibald P Pond the plaintiff, and make report to this Court in order to official decree.
