On motion of the plaintiff it is resolved that this suit be conducted in the name
of Achibald P Pond his having arrived to the age of twenty one years; and this
Court is to be heard on the bill answer and exhibits filed, and was agreed by counsel
on considerations whereof the Court doth adjudge and award that Edmund
Butts after giving at least twenty days notice of the time and place of sale at the
door of the Courthouse of this County and at such other places as may be deemed
convenient all to the highest bidder on some Court day at the Courthouse of this
County the slaves held by the defendant until sold for life and the
remainder in which belongs to the complainant Achibald P Pond for ready money;
that after paying the expenses of sale and of this suit the said Commissioners pay
to Clement Rockelle late Sheriff of Southampton County the sum of fifty thousand
dollars and fifty seven Cents intended to be used for the support of the said slaves
since the same have been under his care by virtue of an interlocutory order of this
Court, and that of the note given by him pay over to Edmund Butts whom the
parties agree to be the purchaser from the said Mollony of his interest in said
slaves one seventh part being retained by the Court an equivalent for the life estate
of the said Harriette Mollony in said slaves, three of the balance pay to the said
Edmund Butts as purchaser agreed in right of said Mollony & wages those tenth
and the other seven tenths pay to Achibald P Pond the plaintiff, and make
report to this Court in order to a final decree.
