This cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and the report
of the Commissioner made pursuant to the order of the first day of November 1841, to
which no exception has been filed, and was argued by Counsel. On consideration
whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree, that Hemming T Smith, Matthew
W Vaughan and Harrison Cobb, Oliver Hawsor and Samuel R Cordner, out of
their own estates pay to Hemming T Smith a surviving brother of Mervish Parker deceased
the sum of three hundred and ninety two dollars and ninety cents with legal inter-
est on two hundred and ninety four dollars sixty seven and two third cents paid
thereof from the 31st day of December 1840 till paid; and to Frederick Parker a like sum
of three hundred and ninety two dollars and ninety cents with legal interest on two
hundred and ninety five dollars sixty seven and two third cents paid thereof from the
31st day of December 1840 till paid; and to Harrison Parker the sum of three hundred
and ninety two dollars and ninety cents with legal interest on two hundred
and ninety five dollars sixty seven and two third cents paid thereof from the 31st day
of December 1840 till paid; and that the defendants pay to the complainant
his costs in this behalf expended. But the said Frederick Parker, Hemming T Smith
administrators of Mervish Parker deceased and Harrison Parker are not to
have the benefit of this decree until each of them or some person for him, shall
execute to the said Hemming T Smith, Matthew W Vaughan and Harrison Cobb
executors of Harrison Parker deceased a bond in the penalty of seven hundred and
eighty five dollars and eighty cents with good security conditioned to refund due
proportion of any debt or demands that may hereafter arise against the estate of
Harrison Parker deceased together with the costs attending the same which
bonds shall be filed in this cause.

for confessed as to those defendants, and the cause coming on to be heard on the bill,
