Federus Parker an infant who sued by Wiley Parker his next friend. Plaintiff  
against

Henning T. Smith, Matthew W. Vaughan and Harrison Cobb, executors of  
Harrison Parker deceased, Edwin Hanson, Samuel R. Gardner, Henning T.  
Smith, administrator of Marcell Parker deceased and Harrison Parker,  
infant by Edwards Wells his guardian ad litem. Defendants.

This cause comes on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and the report  
of the Commissioner made pursuant to the order of the first day of November 1841, to  
which no exception has been filed, and was argued by Counsel. On Consideration  
whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree, that Henning T. Smith, Matthew  
W. Vaughan and Harrison Cobb, Edwin Hanson and Samuel R. Gardner, out of  
that sum now stated pay to Henning T. Smith administrator of Marcell Parker deceased  
the sum of three hundred and ninety two dollars and ninety cents with legal interest  
at six per cent and ninety five dollars sixty seven and two third cents part thereof from the  
31<sup>st</sup> day of December 1840 till paid, and to Federus Parker a like sum  
of three hundred and ninety two dollars and ninety cents with legal interest on one hundred  
and ninety five dollars sixty seven and two third cents part thereof from the 31<sup>st</sup> day  
of December 1840 till paid, and that the defendants pay to the Plaintiff  
his costs in this behalf expended. But the said Federus Parker, Henning T. Smith  
administrator of Marcell Parker deceased and Harrison Parker are not to  
have the benefit of this decree until each of them or some person for him, shall  
execute to the said Henning T. Smith, Matthew W. Vaughan and Harrison Cobb  
executors of Harrison Parker deceased a bond in the penalty of seven hundred and  
eighty five dollars and eighty cents with good security conditioned to refund due  
proportion of any bills or demands that may hereafter arise against the estate of  
Harrison Parker deceased together with the costs attending the same which  
bonds shall be filed in this cause.

still failing to appear and answer. On motion of the Plaintiff his bill is taken  
for confessed as to those defendants, and the cause coming on to be heard on the bill  
answer of the infant defendants by their guardian ad litem, and general affidavit  
thereto and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth order
