This cause came on this day by consent of parties to be heard on the papers formerly read, and the report of the Commissioner made pursuant to an order of November term 1841, to which there is no exception (the exceptions of the plaintiff having been withdrawn) and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court confirming the said report, and being of opinion, that Anna Baiter the intestate of the plaintiff, deceased James Fells the testator of the defendant, doth adjudge, order and decree, that the defendant Alfred T Bailey administrator de bonis non with the will annexed of James Fells dec^d pay to Thomas J Baiter administrator of Anna Baiter deceased the sum of twenty nine thousand eight hundred and seventy four dollars and seventy two cents principal and interest, with interest on twenty eight thousand two hundred and forty six dollars and sixteen cents, part thereof from the 31st day of December 1841 till paid, and with interest on eight hundred and thirty dollars and twenty seven cents, the residue of the principal from the 21st day of February 1842 till paid. And liberty is hereby reserved to the plaintiff to ask hereafter any further decree which may be necessary in relation to the re-administered estate of the testator James Fells. But the plaintiff is not to have the benefit of this decree until he or some person for him shall enter into bond with sufficient security payable to Alfred T Bailey administrator with the will annexed of James Fells deceased or as personally liable the consent hereby decreed, tendered to refund any debt or demands which may afterwards appear against the estate of James Fells deceased and all costs attending the recovery thereof.
