Leon Dows Sheriff of Southampton County and administrator de bonis non with the will annexed of Thomas Gray dec^d. Thomas R. Gray, Edwin Gray and Gray, Nathan Parsons in his own right and as surviving partner of Seth R. Strong & Co^s and also as Executor of R. Strong dec^d and Ellen Douglas Gray Defts

The defendant Nathan Parsons who is out of this country, and against whom the plaintiff appears to have proceeded in the mode prescribed by law against absent defendants still failing to appear and answer, on motion of the plaintiff by Counsel, the Court doth take his bill for confessed as to that defendant and the substance in this case having been executed, and the awarded bill filed more than two months the same is taken for confessed as to the defendant Thomas R. Gray, and the said cause with the other defendants came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read and the reports of the Commissioner made in pursuance of the orders made on the 19th of December 1858 and the 3^d of April 1860 to which no exception has been filed and was argued by Counsel: On consideration whereof the Court comprising said reports, doth adjudge, order and decree that the bills of the complainant as to Leon Dows administrator of Thomas Gray deceased, Thomas R. Gray, Edwin Gray, Ann Gray and Ellen Douglas Gray leghees and devisees of said Thomas Gray be dismissed, and that the plaintiff pay to them their costs in this behalf expended. And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that the defendant and Nathan Parsons surviving partner of Seth R. Strong & Co^s pay to the plaintiff, Jacob H. Duchs the sum of five hundred and fifty five dollars and sixty cents with interest on three hundred and seventy dollars ninety six cents part thereof from the 31st day of December 1858 till paid, and that he pay to the said plaintiff his costs in this behalf expended - But this decree is not to prejudice Seth R. Strong & Co^s nor the said Nathan Parsons surviving ^{partner} of Seth R. Strong & Co^s in the prosecution of any part which may be hereafter brought against the defendant Thomas R. Gray assignor in the manner charged in the original bill. And Liberty is reserved hereby to the executor of Thomas Gray dec^d: to prosecute and recover their claims by another suit out of the real and personal estate of which he said Thos. Gray died entitled.

Ordered the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning ten o'clock.
