

for more than two months and he still failing to appear and answer on motion of the Plaintiff the bill is taken as confessed as to him and it further appearing to the Court that the slaves in the bill mentioned cannot be divided in kind the Court by consent of parties doth order adjudge and decree that Moses Harris, Wm A Jones and Henry Moore who are appointed Commissioners for that purpose sell at public auction after twenty days notice of the time and place of sale on a credit of twelve months the negro slaves Sarah Bob & Nancy in the possession of Cassin B. K. Land and take three several bonds of equal amount with sufficient security and assign one to Nathaniel Thomas one to John A. Thomas and the other to the Defendant Cassin B. K. Land as assignee of David H. Thomas and that the said Commissioners make up audit & settle an account of the hires of said slaves from the 1st day of January 1837 and make report thereof to this Court in order to a final decree.
