

for more than two months and he still failing to appear and answer, on motion of the Plaintiff the bill is taken as confessed as to him and is further affording to the Court that the slaves in the bill mentioned cannot be divided, in kind the Court by consent of parties doth order adjudge and direct that Horace Harris, Wm A Jones and Henry Moore also are appointed Commissioners for that purpose sell at public auction after twenty days notice of the time and place of sale, on a credit of twelve months the negro slaves such Bob & Nancy in the possession of Edwin B. Clarendon and take there separate bonds of equal amount with sufficient security and upon one to Nathan A. Thomas one to Tom A. Thomas and the other to the defendant Edwin B. Clarendon as aforesaid of David H. Thomas, and that the said Commissioners make up and settle an account of the horses and slaves from the 1st day of January 1837, and make report thereof to this Court in order to a final decree.
