This day this cause came on again to be heard on the papers formerly read, and the reports of the Commissioners returned September the 20th 1841, and under the decree of November Term 1842 to which reports there are no exceptions, together with the statement marked A, filed herewith, and was argued by Counsel. Blund dec^d the sum of three hundred and sixty four dollars seventy seven cents of principal and eighty two dollars eighty four cents of interest, with interest on the principal sum from the 31st day of December 1842 till paid. To Peter Edwards and at witness his wife One hundred and twenty one dollars fifty eight cents of principal and twenty eight 94⁷/₁₀₀ dollars of interest with interest on the principal sum from the 31st day of December 1842 till paid. To Joseph T. Blund administrator of Robert T.
