This day the causes came on to be heard together on the papers formerly read and on the reports of Commissioner Wells and on the exceptions of Nathan Thomas and E B Claul shewd and the Court sustaining the exception of Claul, and overruling the exception of Nathan Thomas confirms the said Report in all other thing. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree, that Edmund B Claul pay to John Thomas the sum of two hundred and eight dollars, with interest thereon from the 21st day of December 1842 till paid, and that he retain the sum of two hundred and forty four dollars with like interest as his own portion of the amount of hire of the Slaves in the proceedings mentioned, and that Nathan Thomas pay to John Thomas the sum of thirty six dollars with interest from 31st December 1842 till paid and that he retain the sum of two hundred and forty four dollars his portion of the hire of the Slaves - It is further ordered and decreed that Edmund B Claul Nathan Thomas and John Thomas pay equally the costs of these suits.

1st An account of the administration of Thomas Buller in the estate of Benjamin Breezy
2nd An account of the administration of William A Everett in the estate of said Benjamin Breezy
3rd An account of the Plaintiff demand
4th An account of the absolute and annual value of the real estate descended from the said Benjamin Breezy to any of the Defendants herein whether the same has been sold and conveyed or so to whom and for what price, in taking the administration account the Commissioner is to ascertain what debts paid by the administratoe toward the heirs of the
