French and by consent of parties, his answer is filed. Whereupon this cause this day came on to be heard on the original and amended bills and exhibits, the answers of Thobell executor of Simmons and French, and replication thereto, and was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof, the Court doth order that the defendant Poynt render before a Commissioner of this Court an account of all monies received by him as Executor Henry Muelin on account of the plaintiff and all proper and legal expenses paid for him - That the said Poynt also render before the said Commissioner an account of his wrongs and wrongs on the estate of his testator Henry Muelin. And the Court doth further order that the defendant Thobell executor of Henry Simmons die' render before the said Commissioner an account of the transactions of his executor on the estate of Henry Simmons die' and an account of his own transactions as Executor of the said Henry Simmons - which said Commissioner is directed to examine, state and settle said accounts and make report thereof with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which may be required by the parties or either of them to be so stated.
