This cause came on this day to be heard on the bill and answer and application  
therein with the exhibits and proofs filed in the cause and was argued by Counsel. On con-  
sideration whereof the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that the injunction awarded  
the plaintiff the 26<sup>th</sup> day of December 1842 to injure the Defendant from selling  
the slaves Comfort, Dany and Margaret in the bill mentioned, under no execution  
issued out of the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Superior Court of Law and Chancery  
for the County of Southampton in favour of the defendant against Samuel B. Stone  
be made perpetual: and that the defendant do pay to the plaintiff her costs by her  
agent her debt on this behalf expended.

On motion of the plaintiff & for reasons appearing to the Court the Court doth set  
aside the order of October Term 1842 & thereupon this cause came on to be heard  
upon the papers formerly read and was argued by Counsel: on consideration whereof the  
Court approving the reports made by Court. Justice Mason in pursuance of orders  
heretofore made in the cause doth confirm the same: and accepting the statement filed  
among the papers: doth adjudge, order & decree that the defendants Geo  
Blow exec of Gray Fells dec<sup>d</sup> out of his own estate & the Deft. Thos. H. Fells exec of  
Minge Fells dec<sup>d</sup>: who was adm<sup>r</sup> of the same decedent out of the op<sup>t</sup>s of his  
intestate in his hands to be administered of so much thereof he hath as pay to the  
plff the sum of \$6,700 with interest from Dec 31, 1835 till paid: & that the  
defend<sup>t</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Thornton adm<sup>r</sup> of Geo Bain dec<sup>d</sup> out of the op<sup>t</sup>s of his intestate in his  
hands to be administered of so much thereof he hath as pay to the plff the further  
sum of \$1250<sup>00</sup> with interest from Dec 31, 1837 till paid & his cost in this  
behalf expended: and liberty is granted to the plff to resort to the Court for an  
account of the op<sup>t</sup>s in the hands of S<sup>r</sup> Thornton adm<sup>r</sup> as aforesaid or to either of the  
other parties for relief in case the same against them aforesaid should not be paid.

Ordered that the Court be adjourned till tomorrow morning Ten O'clock
