This cause came on this day by consent of parties to be heard on the bill answer of the defendant Joseph T Liles general replication and exhibits, and by like consent the Court, not settling any of the principles of the cause, but reserving them for adjudication at the final hearing, doth adjudge, order and decree that James Bell of Hampshire, single in the State of North Carolina, who is hereby appointed with the consent of all parties a Special Commissioner, settle an account of the co-partnership of Liles, Barnes & Co. in the proceedings mentioned; that he ascertain as far as he can all outstanding debts due by the said firm and their respective amounts; and that he make a statement showing the amount due to and from each of the partners or their representatives of such as are dead - all which he will report to the Court with such matters as he may deem pertinent to be specially stated or which either of the parties may require to be settled.

This day this cause came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read, and the report of James W Munger and Harrison Bell, also of Wm S Goodwyn made in obedience to an order of this Court pronounced at April Term 1843 to which reports there are no exceptions, and the Court affirming said reports doth adjudge, order and decree that William C Parker and James W Williamson who are appointed Commissioners for that purpose out of the cash returned with the report of Munger & Bell pay to James Bell the sum of Eighty two dollars and five cents with interest on eighty one dollars forty six cents part thereof from December the 16th 1843 till paid being the balance due him on his administration account of David Bell's estate. The Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that
