The defendants Isaac Johnson and his wife Priscilla who are out of this country and
against whom the plaintiff appears to have proceeded in the mode prescribed by law against
such defendants, still failing to appear and answer and it appearing to the Court that
more than two months have elapsed since the service of the subpoena on the defendant Isaac
Johnson and also since the filing of the bill, who still fails to answer. On motion of the plaintiff
by Counsel, his bill is taken for confessed. And the cause coming on to be heard on the bill and
amended bill exhibits filed and examination of witnesses, was argued by Counsel. On considera-
tion whereof the Court doth order adjudged and decree that the plaintiff recover of the defendant
Isaac Johnson the sum of fifty dollars and twenty nine cents with interest from the 20th of
February 1822 till paid and his costs by him about his suit on this behalf aforesaid. And it ap-
pearing to the Court that the defendant Peter D Beckman hath in his hands funds belong-
ing to the said Johnson sufficient to pay the said demand, it is further ordered that the said
Beckman pay to the plaintiff in satisfaction of the said debt the sum of Fifty dollars and
twenty nine cents with interest from the 20th February 1822 till paid together with the costs
of this suit. But the effect of this decree is to be suspended until the plaintiff shall have
entered into bond with sufficient security in the State's Office of this Court in a penalty equal
to double the money recovered to be paid by the resident defendant with such condition as the law
requires in case of absent defendants -
