The defendant Thomas D. Davis who is out of this country, and against whom the plaintiff  
applies to have proceeded in the mode prescribed by law against whom defendants still failing to  
appear and answer, or action of the plaintiff by himself, his bill is taken for confessed acts that  
defendant, And the cause coming on to be heard on the bill and untried bill and exhibits and over-  
parts of the defendant Vaughan, was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof, the court doth  
adjudge order and decree that the defendant Thomas D. Davis pay to the plaintiff Cuthbert D.  
Barnard the sum of twenty nine dollars forty three cents with interest thereon from the 12<sup>th</sup> day  
of October 1840 till paid together with the sum of four dollars forty six cents, and also the  
further sum of twenty dollars & thirteen cents with interest thereon from the 9<sup>th</sup> day of October  
1844 till paid, together with the costs of this suit. And the court doth further order, adjudge  
and decree that the plaintiff's bill be dismissed as to the defendant Vaughan and that he  
recover of the plaintiff his costs expended in defending this suit.
