And the cause coming on to be heard on the bill and amended bill and exhibits and answer of the defendant Venghent, was argued by Counsel. On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that the defendant Thomas D. Neale pay to the plaintiff Cuthbert D. Bachman the sum of twenty nine dollars twenty three cents with interest thereon from the 12th day of October 1840 together with the sum of four dollars forty six cents. and also the further sum of twenty dollars & thirteen cents with interest thereon from the 9th day of October 1841 together with the costs of this suit. And the Court doth further order, adjudge and decree that the plaintiff's bill be dismissed as to the Defendant Venghent and that he recover of the plaintiff his costs expended in defending this suit.
