William P Goddard a true and perfect account of all and on additional account of her transmission  
to the estate of her said Testator, in which the accounts filed as an exhibit in the  
bill and answer marked, B. and A. shall be taken prima facie correct by reason of  
parties, subject to be discharged and falsified, which account the said Commissioner is  
hereby directed to take and settle with any master named particular by himself or  
required by the parties. That the said defendant do also render before the said Com-  
missioner an account of the number and names of the slaves belonging to Henry W  
Long at the time of his death and the numbers and names of the increase since  
with the names of those who have died. also an account of any that may have been  
sold by his Testator or himself and the several values thereof when sold. also an  
account of the lives or annual value of the slaves since the death of the said  
Henry W Long - which said account the said Commissioner is also directed to take  
and settle with any master named particular or required by the parties -
