Maysenburg who is hereby appointed a Commissioner shall after giving notice of the time and place of sale at the door of the Lawhouse of this County and at some other place near the premises for twenty days sell to the highest bidder for cash the lands of Louis Simmons which descended to her from Benjamin Drury, and out of the proceeds of sale pay to the said plaintiff the said sum of forty seven dollars and fifty cents with interest from this day; and that the defendants pay to the plaintiff his costs expended in the prosecution of this suit; and that the Commissioner
