It appearing to the satisfaction of the court that the plaintiff has proceeded
in the cause presented by him against above defendants and the defendant
of H. H. Pond, Robert Drury & John H. Hill still failing to appear and answer
the plaintiffs bill is taken for confessed as to these defendants and it appearing
that the subpoena awarded in the cause has been executed on all the
other defendants who still fail to appear and answer although two months have
elapsed as well since the service of the said subpoena as since the plaintiff filed
his original and amended bill the same are taken for confessing as to these
defendants and thereupon this court this day came on to be heard
on the bill of the plaintiff and the papers formerly read and in the Report
of Commissioner etc made in pursuance of an order of the court pronounced at
the October Term 1841 and was argued by counsel for the plaintiff and the
Court affirming the same Report, to which there is no exception etc adjudge
order and decree that the defendant James H. Pond, pay to the plaintiff
Alice Morris the sum of five hundred and twenty seven dollars and eighty
four cents plus interest, judgment at the rate of 6% per annum, for and on
said October 3 1840 till paid and the costs of this suit, and of the above
should be recovered against the said Pond there being a decree to the
plaintiff to process by proper service to recover the sum due from
the defendant Robert L. Drury, S. M. Pond, John H. Hill, John H. Billings and
Patrick H. Billings in either of them.
