the Court approving that aspect of the said report in which the defendant French is made to account as trustee, for the proceeds of the Roman Land, and substantiating the opinion that the said defendant under the circumstances of the case has no right to call upon the plaintiffs to refund to him on account of the sale of the horse Wellington; and the defendant French asking for no decree against the defendant Sarah Payne for the crops which he has paid to her, over the amount to which she was by said report entitled, doth adjudge, order and decree that the said defendant James P French pay to the defendant Richard Gordon the sum of Five hundred and sixteen dollars and forty nine cents with interest thereon from the 1st day of January 1842 till paid. To the defendant Thomas Emerson five hundred and fifty two dollars and twenty cents with interest thereon from the 1st day of January 1842 till paid and to the plaintiff Edmund Jones the sum of Eight hundred and twenty five dollars with interest thereon from the 1st day of January 1842 till paid, and that each party pay his own costs. But he enjoin of this decree as to costs the defendant French to pay to the plaintiff Edmund Jones eight hundred and twenty five dollars with interest from the 1st day of January 1842 is to be suspended until the said Jones shall produce to this Court evidence of the payment to Joseph Allen of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars on the proceedings mentioned.

This day this cause came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read and on the report of the Commissioners, made in pursuance of an order of this Court pronounced at November Term 1841 to which report there is no exception, and the Court confirming the said report, doth adjudge, order and decree that unless the defendants or some one or more persons for them, shall within four months from the date of this decree, pay the debts ascertained to be due from Benjamin Turner dec^d by the Commissioners report V^{rs}.

To Lewis Harris two hundred and eighty three dollars eighty three cents with interest on two hundred & seventy five dollars part thereof from the 15th day of November 1839 till paid.

To John B Moore two hundred and eight dollars eighty three cents with interest on two hundred dollars part thereof from the 22nd day of June 1838 till paid.
