the Court approving that aspect of the said report in which the defendant French is made to account as trustee for the proceeds of the Bonner Land, and entertaining the opinion that the said defendant under the circumstances of the case has no right to call upon the plaintiff to refund to him on account of the sale of the town Wellington; and the defendant French asking for no decree against the defendant Sarah Payne for the sum which he has paid to her, over the amount to which she was by said report entitled, doth adjudge and declare that the said defendant James P. French pay to the defendant Richard Davis the sum of Five hundred and sixteen dollars and forty nine cents with interest thereon from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1842 till paid. To the defendant Thomas Penruess five hundred and fifty two dollars and twenty cents with interest thereon from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1842 till paid and to the plaintiff Edmund Jones the sum of Eight hundred and twenty five dollars with interest thereon from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1842 till paid and that each party pay his own costs. Not so much of this decree as directs the defendant French to pay to the plaintiff Edmund Jones eight hundred and twenty five dollars with interest from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of January 1842 is to be suspended until the said Jones shall produce to this Court evidence of the payment to Joseph Allen of the sum of fifteen hundred dollars on the proceedings mentioned.

This day this cause came on to be further heard on the papers formerly read and on the report hereinbefore left, made in pursuance of an order of this Court pronounced at November term 1844 to which report there is no exception, and the Court confirming the said report, doth adjudge, order and decree that unless the defendant or some one or more persons for whom, shall within four months from the date of this decree, pay the debts ascertained to be due from Benjamin Turner dec<sup>d</sup> by the Commissioner's report Vizt:-

To Jno Turner 92 dollars with interest on 12<sup>th</sup> of April 1832 till paid -

To S. Edwards administrator of Benjamin Edwards dec<sup>d</sup> fifty eight dollars and eighty three cents with interest on fifty dollars part thereof from the 15<sup>th</sup> day of October 1830 till paid -

To Henry Moore and Nathaniel Francis administrators of Joseph Francis dec<sup>d</sup> One hundred and ninety one dollars and fifty seven cents with interest on One hundred and forty seven dollars seventy four cents part thereof from the 21<sup>st</sup> day of December 1834 till paid -

To John D. Strong for Robert Souller Seventy two dollars & twenty cents with interest on Sixty three dollars & eighty two cents part thereof from the 26<sup>th</sup> day of June 1834 till paid -
