It appearing to the Court that since the last hearing of this cause, that Benjamin
 Griffin the Committee of Peter North has departed this life and Goodwin G. Griffin
 has been appointed Committee of said Peter - that Ann Rollings wife of Patrick
 H. Rollings has died and administration on her estate has been committed to her
 husband Patrick H. Rollings - that Martha Morris wife of Edmund Morris
 has died and her estate has been committed to Robert Eldridge Sheriff of Sussex
 for administration - that Susan Fairson has departed this life and John E.
 Nicholas has qualified as her administrator - that Peter W. Warren, Lewis A.
 Branch and Eliza M. North have died and their estates have been committed
 to the hands of William J. Everett Sheriff of Southampton for administration
 and a Sure Fides to revive the cause in the name of William J. Everett
 Sheriff and Committee of Peter W. Warren, Lewis A. Branch and Eliza M.
 North having been duly executed - and by consent of parties the cause is
 revived in the name of Goodwin G. Griffin Committee of the estate of Peter North
 Patrick H. Rollings administrator of Ann his wife, Robert Eldridge Sheriff of Sussex
 County and administrator of Martha Morris, John E. Nicholas, administrator of Susan
 Fairson - And thereupon by consent this cause came on to be heard on the papers formerly
 made, and on the report of Commissioners left made in pursuance of an order of this Court
 of December Term 1838 to which report there being no exception thereto the Court doth
 confirm - And on the statement filed in this cause marked (A. B.) On consideration
 of all which the Court doth adjudge, order and decree that Edwards Watts
 administrator de bonis non of Peter North dec^d pay to John Southall and
 Polly his wife the sum of thirteen hundred and twenty dollars and no part with
 interest on seven hundred and twenty six dollars sixty five cents paid thereof
 from December 31st 1834 till paid. To Goodwin G. Griffin Committee of Peter
 North a like sum with like interest. To Patrick H. Rollings administrator of
 Ann Rollings dec^d a like sum with like interest. To Robert Eldridge Sheriff of
 Sussex County and Committee of the estate of Martha Morris a like sum with
 like interest. To Thomas J. Butler executor of Thomas Butler dec^d who it appears
 to the Court purchased from Elizabeth P. Devney a like sum with like
 interest by consent of said Devney. That Edwards Watts who it appears
