

At Prince and Elizabeth his wife pay to the said Joshua, Cornelius and Rosa Island.
 The sum of One dollar eighty seven and a half cents with interest from this day till paid
 That Adeline Island pay to Peter D. Dickman and Martha his wife the sum of
 sixty four dollars thirty seven and a half cents with interest from this day till paid
 and that Elizabeth Island the said do pay to the said Joshua, Cornelius and Rosa
 Island the sum of seven dollars and fifty cents with interest from this day till paid
 The said several amounts being necessary according to the said report to equalize the
 several lots of lands assigned to the different legacies - And the Court doth further
 adjudge, order and decree that Joseph H. Prince Executor of Joseph H. Island dec^d
 do after reasonable notice of time and place of sales, proceed to sell the nine tract
 of land and the Thos. D. Reidley tract of land in the proceedings mentioned the first upon
 a credit of One, two and three years, and the last upon a credit of one and two years taking
 bonds and good security from the purchasers and as a further security return the title to the
 said lands until the purchase money is paid - and make report to Court with any matters
 specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which any of the parties may require
 to be so stated - And the Court doth further adjudge, order and decree that the Defend-
 ant Joseph H. Prince Executor of Joseph H. Prince render before Wm. J. Goddard one of
 the Commissioners of this Court an account of his transactions on the estate of the said Joseph
 H. Island dec^d who is directed to examine the same and sell the same and make report to the
 Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which may be
 required to state by either of the parties - And the Court is of opinion that the said
 the said Elizabeth Island has renounced the provisions of the will of the said Jo^s
 H. Island. Joseph H. Island is not entitled to the stock, horse crops bequeathed to him,
 or to require the Executor to remove the house on the Warham land & have it put
 up on the land devised to him, but the ^{that} stock, ^{crops} horse ~~of~~ should be disposed of by the
 executor as the other personal estate of the testator, and that no charge should be
 allowed by the Commissioner to the Executor for any expenses of removing the horse
 assigned from the Warham land And as to all other matters this cause is continued.
