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Joseph T Oland administrator of Theophilus Barrow dec^d and Benjamin Griffin Sheriff and administrator of Richard Barrow dec^d having departed this life and the estate of the said Theophilus Barrow having been committed into the hands of Samuel W Hines Sheriff of Southampton and Robert B Griffin having qualified as Executor of Benjamin Griffin and the estate of Richard Barrow having also been committed to the hands of Samuel W Hines Sheriff of Southampton County - On motion of the said Samuel W Hines administrator of the said Theophilus Barrow this suit is removed in his name as plaintiff - And on motion of the said Samuel W Hines and by consent of Robert B Griffin executor the said suit is removed against him as Executor of Benjamin Griffin and against the said Samuel W Hines Sheriff and administrator of Richard Barrow. And thereupon this cause came on by consent of parties to be heard on the papers formerly read, and on the report of Commissioner Goodwyn made in obedience of May Term 1844 to which report there is no exception and was argued by plaintiff counsel. On consideration whereof the Court confirming the report of Commissioner Goodwyn with by consent of parties adjudge, order and decree that Commissioner Goodwyn take a further account of the transactions of Benjamin Griffin upon the estate of Richard Barrow and make report thereof to Court with any matters specially stated deemed pertinent by himself or which any of the parties may require to be so stated.
