This day came the plaintiffs by their counsel and the said James being returned duly exhibited on the defendants they were solemnly called but came not. Therefore it is considered that the said decree stand and be received and be in full force and that the defendants Hemming J. Smith & Matthew W. Vaughan and James Cobb out of the estate of his intestate Harrison Cobb in his hands to be administered pay unto Hemming J. Smith administrator of Maria Parker dec^d the sum of three hundred and seven dollars seventy three and a half cents with legal interest on two hundred and sixty three dollars twenty two cents part thereof from the 31st day of December 1840 till paid and to Samuel B. Hines Sheriff of Southampton County and administrator of Amanda Gatlung dec^d the like sum of three hundred and seven dollars seventy three and a half cents with legal interest thereon from that on two hundred and sixty three dollars and seventy two cents part thereof from the 31st day of December 1840 till paid the debts and that the said Hemming J. Smith & Matthew W. Vaughan surviving executors of Harrison Parker dec^d out of the estate of their Testator in their hands to be administered pay to the said Hemming J. Smith administrator of Maria Parker dec^d and Samuel B. Hines Sheriff of Southampton County & administrator of Amanda Gatlung dec^d \$42.07 cents the costs in the writ aforesaid specified according to the form and effect thereof and also that the said Hemming J. Smith & Matthew W. Vaughan & James Cobb administrators of Harrison Cobb dec^d out of the estate of his intestate in his hands to be administered pay to the plaintiffs their costs by them expended in bringing forth and prosecuting this writ.
