This court on this day doth direct by counsel of parties and by this court come in
 to be heard or the bill answers exhibits and depositions of witnesses and was argued
 by counsel On consideration whereof and by virtue of the authority vested in
 this Court by the act of the general assembly of Virginia passed January
 25. 1548 referred to us the proceedings the Court doth adjudge order
 and decree that Thomas R. Gibson and 28 W. Towne who are hereby appointed
 Commissioners for the purposes do after advertising the day of sale for one
 month in some paper published in the town of Petersburg and in the City
 of Norfolk and at Annapolis and other public place in the County of Mathews
 two still at public auction or the premises the Land in the County of Mathews
 known as poplar Swamp upon a credit of six mo. and there upon annual
 payments requiring only cash enough to pay the expense of this sale and
 the sale taking from the purchaser a purchasers bond with good security
 and retaining a lien on the land until the purchase money is paid
 and the said Commissioners are authorized in writing said sale to sell the
 whole tract together or to sell the same in parcels as they may find the
 interest of the parties require and they will make Report of these
