I find

This cause came on this day to be tried against Plaintiff and the papers formerly read and the Report of the Commissioner made in pursuance of the order of the 18th of November 1845 to which no objection is filed and was argued by counsel On consideration whereof the Court confirming the said Report doth adjudge and direct that the defendant George W Powell do pay to the Plaintiff George J Powell the sum of twenty eight hundred and four dollars and twenty three cents with interest on the sum of twenty two hundred and twenty seven dollars and twenty three cents part thereof from the 18th of August 1845 until paid and that he pay to the Plaintiff Joseph D Powell and Mary J Powell his wife the sum of nineteen hundred and thirty dollars and fifty seven cents with interest on the sum of fifteen hundred and fifty eight dollars and thirty seven cents part thereof from the 18th of August 1845 until paid and the Court doth further adjudge and direct that the defendant George W Powell do pay to the Plaintiff the costs of this suit and the expenses of service and serving a warrant on the Plaintiff to apply towards further costs if the defendant if their default should prove unavoidable

The Bill in this cause having been filed and the Plaintiff executed on the defendant Richard Hallcome more than two months and he still failing & refusing and unanswer the Bill the Master of the Plaintiff by his counsel & a Notary that the same Statute for causes of action to stand defendant and the cause coming on this day to be heard on the Bill and exhibits were argued by counsel On consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge and direct that unto the said defendant Richard Hallcome going to the Plaintiff the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars with interest from the 1st day of January 1845 till paid being the balance due for the purchase of the tract of Land in the Bill mentioned as shown by the bond of the defendant filed in and written with the Bill together with the costs of the suit, which are hereby adjudged to the said Plaintiff or before the 1st day of January next, then and in that case ... ^{John} T Edwards who is hereby appointed Special Commissioner for that purpose having first given ^{publicly} Notice of the time and place of sale by advertisement at the Court House door of this County or some Court day and at Victoria the market public place to the notice of the citizen and in one of the newspapers published in Petersburg Bill at public auction to the highest bidder upon a credit of six months except for the expenses of sale which shall be for tract of land and buildings from the purchaser and retaining the title to the premises all those two certain bonds of record with the appearance signed in this County which were given by the Plaintiff to the defendant, as mentioned and described in the Bill filed in and exhibited with the Bill
