This cause came on the day to be again heard on the papers formerly read and
the Report of the Commissioner made in pursuance of the order of the 18th of
November 1843 to which no exception is filed and was argued by counsel
On consideration whereof the Court confirming the said Report doth adjudge
order and decree that the defendant George W Powell do pay to the plaintiff
Septima J Powell the sum of twenty eight hundred and four dollars and
twenty three cents with interest but the sum of twenty two hundred and
twenty three dollars and twenty three cents past thereof from the 18th of August
1843 until paid and that he pay to the plaintiff Joseph B Powell and
Mary J Powell his wife the sum of nineteen hundred and ninety dollars
and fifty seven cents with interest on the sum of fifteen hundred and
fifty eight dollars and twenty seven cents past thereof from the 18th of
August 1843 until paid and the Court doth further adjudge order
and decree that the defendant George W Powell do pay to the plaintiff
the cost by them in this behalf expended and having a warrant to
the plaintiff to apply for a writ for further relief against the other
defendants if this decree should prove unsatisfactory

The Bill in this cause having been filed and the Subpoena returned on the
defendant Richard Halcome was then two months and he still failing to appear
and answer the Bill the Motion of the plaintiff by his counsel at a Decree
that the same be taken for confessed as to said defendant and the cause coming
on the day to be heard on the bill and exhibit was argued by counsel On
consideration whereof the Court doth adjudge order and decree that with
the said defendant Richard Halcome pay to the plaintiff the sum of One
hundred and fifty dollars with interest from the 1st day of January 1845
till paid being the balance due for the purchase of the land of Saut in
the bill mentioned as shown by the bond of the defendant filed as an
exhibit with the bill together with the cost of this suit which are hereby
adjudged to the said plaintiff on or before the 1st day of January next
then and in that case ... Fullow & Edwards who is hereby appointed
@ Special Commissioners for that purpose having first given notice of the time and place of sale by advertisement at the Court house
door of this County on some Court day and at Richfield the nearest
public place to the residence of the debtor and in one of the Newspapers
published in Petersburg till at public auction to the highest bidder upon
a credit of 12 months except for the expense of sale which shall be
for cash of the said land and security from the purchaser and retaining the
bills to the premium all these two covenants being to stand with the appurtenances
lying in the land which were by the plaintiff to the defendant as
mentioned and decreed in this bill filed as an exhibit with the bill
