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called her name 2d. It appeared the bank and resident being present and
 important it is concluded by the bank that the plaintiff being here remains
 against the defendant for four hundred and eighty eight dollars and eight
 and the plaintiff of one hundred and two and a half in the defendant's name
 that the bank defendant is obliged to that the bank and is a discharge
 by the payment of her hundred and twenty eight dollars and seventy and
 legal interest therefrom the 5th day of January 1892 and that the
 bank and the plaintiff as paid bank interest to the defendant seventy
 eight dollars and fifty six cents part of the debt appeared therefore in a
 that manner the defendant is acquitted and discharged.

It is ordered that she bank be required to do so in case of her debt
