 Report of Commissioner Westinghouse made in pursuance of an order of the Court at
 November Term 1844 to which there is no exception and the Court considering
 said Report doth adjudge and decree that unless Nancy Bay, William Walker
 George and Richard Bay or some one for them shall over before the 1st
 day of January 1847 pay to Alexander Fawcett the sum of thirty three
 dollars & twenty two cents with interest one shilling two pence and thirty three
 cents each party jointly from January 1st 1843 to George W. Westman twenty
 six dollars and sixty eight cents with interest from 7th January 1842 to
 twenty dollars and thirty eight cents to Thomas and Adams thirty one dollars
 and thirty two cents with interest from 25th May 1842 to S. Alfred S. Smith
 thirteen dollars and forty four cents with interest 10th August 1843 to Early
 Bay twenty seven dollars and thirty seven cents with interest from 10th
 September 1830 and to A. Atherton four dollars above the Sheriff of
 Southampton who is appointed a Commissioner for this purpose shall after giving
 thirty day notice of the time & place of sale by advertisement at the Court
 house door of the County on some Court day and at two or more places in
 the highest part of the land till on the premises to the highest bidder and
 one of the twelve months next after the sale shall be paid to the Court and
 expenses of sale all the Land of which George Bay dec'd. alleged that he
 took notice and security of the purchase and return the title all the
 purchase money is paid and that he Report his proceedings to Court
 And the Court doth adjudge order and decree that a Commissioner of
 the Court ascertain the amount due from George Bay to Susan Bay
 as his late husband and Report to Court.
